

Testing for Parasites

You can test for parasites in different ways such as stool, blood, MRI, CT scans and surgical procedures. Yet not one test for parasites is always reliable. The most common test that's done is either stool or blood even though it's not always detected. Same thing applies when testing for parasites in your animals.

Here's an example of someone testing for parasites: A patient sent in a stool sample to the most commonly used tab in L.A. who reported no parasites. A week later, the same patient sent a sample to one of the top labs in the U.S. and they found 3 different types. Not long after, the patient decided to do a cleanse that dislodged long threads of worms. Neither lab located that type of parasite.
